

## James Kane Scholarship Application Form

### About the Scholarship

Southern Regional College is collaborating with the James Kane Trust to launch a scholarship award for Higher Education students living within the Armagh, Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council. Applications are open to any student from this area beginning year 1 on a higher education course in the areas listed below. Each scholarship covers the higher education tuition fee for each successful student for up to a maximum of two years.

### Criteria for Application

All applicants must satisfy the following criteria:

- Applicants must primarily reside within the Armagh, Banbridge & Craigavon Borough Council area.
- Applicants must have applied for one of the courses listed below and be intending to start this course in the 2023-2024 academic year.
- Applicants must be starting year 1 of one of the following higher education programmes:
  - Creative Imaging BA (Hons) Level 6 Degree (part-time)
  - Computing For Industry BSc (Hons) Level 6 Degree (part-time)
  - Creative Music & Audio Production BA (Hons) Level 6 Degree (part-time)
  - Creative Media Production - Film Pathways Level 5 Higher National Diploma (full-time)
  - Creative Media Production - Games Development Pathways Level 5 Higher National Diploma (full-time)
  - Construction (Digital Construction Management) Level 5 Foundation Degree (part-time)
  - Construction (Quantity Surveying) Level 5 Foundation Degree (part-time)
  - Creative Music & Audio Production Level 5 Foundation Degree (full-time)
  - Cloud Computing, Analytics & Security for Industry Level 5 Foundation Degree (part-time)
  - Art & Design - Graphic Design Pathways Level 5 Higher National Diploma (part-time)
- Applicants must provide evidence of meeting the entry criteria for the programme of study applied for.

**Applicants must submit their completed application form by email to roddyc@src.ac.uk by Friday 27th September 2024**

Applicants will be required to provide evidence of meeting the entry criteria.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to deliver a presentation to a panel of College and James Kane Scholarship representatives.

### Terms of Conditions

1. The scholarship is only for fees and cannot be used for anything else.
2. To receive the scholarship, you must be enrolled on one of the qualifying higher education programmes.
3. To apply for this scholarship, your main residence must be within Armagh, Banbridge & Craigavon Borough Council area.
4. The awarding of this scholarship will be based on a selection process.
5. Recipients of the scholarship will not receive any monies directly. The scholarship will be paid directly to the College from the James Kane Foundation.
6. Course fees will be paid by instalment to the College based on good academic standing and continued enrolment status.
7. The scholarship will be for a two-year period from first enrolment on a year 1 of a qualifying programme.
8. Students will only be able to receive a scholarship once and this cannot be transferred to another course.
9. All other College Terms and Conditions apply.
